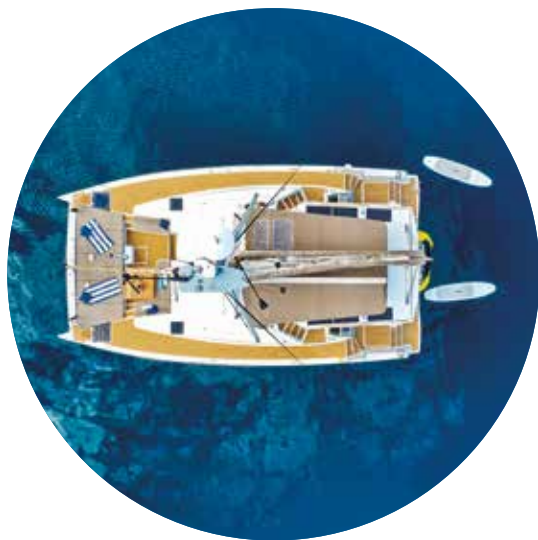

# Jozsef Devenyi

Jozsef and his business partners have successfully engaged with our charter management program for the past 4 years.

My name is Jozsef, friends call me Joe and I am an electrical engineer, founder, co-owner and CEO of Anico Kft HU. My company is in the radio communication business, but I am also a founder, co-owner and CEO of Happy Sailor d.o.o., used for our charter business in Croatia.

Before investing in charter management, I used to charter sailing boats in Croatia at least once a year, for family vacations, usually through a Hungarian agent and we often attended regattas held by Hungarian organizers, along with our friends.

In Spring of 2018 I was attending the so called "Golden shackle Regatta" with my friends and Murter Hramina was our base marina. One evening, we were checking the Internet for boat shows in Croatia and realized that there was an upcoming show in Split on the following weekend. When the regatta has finished, we went to Split. There we met Igor from Croatia Yachting. We were very impressed with Hanse yachts and the professionalism of Croatia Yachting staff during the show. We made a quick calculation and found out that if we purchase a new boat with leasing and leave it in the Croatia Yachting charter fleet, would be a better option than buying 10-year-old boat just for personal use.

Of course, I had a few concerns about the entire process, such as finding a partner for financial leasing. Hungarian banks did not finance boats that are based in Croatia and Croatian banks did not finance Hungarian companies. The suggested solution was to establish a Croatian company we had professional support from the Croatia Yachting team and their affiliates through the entire process.

The business and taxation environment in Croatia is little bit different than in Hungary so it was greatly appreciated that Croatia Yachting provided an attorney and an accounting company to establish our company and run it. I would say that the cooperation Croatia Yachting, the attorney and the accountant was very smooth. They all speak very good English and were very helpful and cooperative.

We use approximately 3-4 owners' weeks a year, usually one week in, or close to high season, during June or September and sometimes in August for a family vacation and other weeks during low season in April, May or October with our friends who also love to sail. On top of that, if there is a vacant week left during the charter season, we make sure to use it for ourselves. Bear in mind that, when owners use their own boats registered for charter, they have to pay some VAT. It is same in Hungary, so we fully understand.

If I disregard the current pandemic, I am very satisfied with the booking results. In a normal charter season, we reach 24-26 booked weeks, including the owners' weeks. Hopefully, the pandemic will be behind us soon or at least decreased and we can all get back to our lives and business as normal.

I am also very satisfied with the maintenance standards for my boats. If I happen to have some questions about the incoming invoices, related to the maintenance and I ask for an explanation, Croatia Yachting is quick to respond.

Even though the last charter season was shorter, the full maintenance still had to be done to keep the boats in top shape, so the maintenance costs remained al-



most the same as in the full charter season.

We have even decided to add some extra features to make our boats even more attractive for charter. These were Webasto heating for pre and after season, radar, cockpit grill, stern thruster and unlimited sailing area registration.

The transparency of the cash flow and maintenance costs are great. Having access to Nausys, an online booking platform, makes everything transparent for us and it is easy to track everything.

Based on my experience with the charter management program, I would recommend Croatia Yachting as reliable partner and for those who are thinking about a new boat and the charter management program, I would suggest bigger boats, above 50ft. There is less competition in the category above 50 feet and the annual overall outcome could be more appealing to those who are aiming for higher return on investment.

# Book, Plan, Sail, Enjoy

When booking a yacht charter holiday, there are several things to consider; in this article, we share some of the FAQs of chartering a yacht.

## Your guide for yacht charter in Croatia

until the end of October; July and August are peak season. However, every year the season extends as more discover the joys of sailing 'off-peak'. Croatia has a Mediterranean climate meaning summer is characterised by hot, sunny days, balmy evenings and warm seas. May, June, September and October have pleasant weather, averaging 20 – 24°C and an average sea temperature of 18°C (65°F), with great winds for sailing. The average temperature in July and August is around 27°C (80°F) and can get as high as 40°C (104°F); there is typically less wind during these months. Depending on your reasons for sailing, you may want to consider sailing off-peak. Also note that prices during these months can be 20 – 50% less with charter costs, mooring fees etc.

### • How to Choose Your Yacht

The first decision you need to make is whether you want a sailboat, catamaran or a motor yacht. Are you about the journey or the destination? Do you prefer sitting beneath the sails and enjoying the journey or do you want to cover more ground and visit more destinations? If you decide on sails, the next question is – do you prefer a sailing yacht (monohull) or catamaran?

### • What Licenses are Required to Bareboat?

According to Croatian law, at least one person aboard must possess a valid nautical and VHF license. To charter a yacht without a skipper, we require these licenses plus sailing experience.

### • Should I Use a Charter Broker?

The first thing to know is that the cost is the same,

as the Charter company (not you) pays the broker's commission. A knowledgeable broker has experience, industry insights and can steer you in the right direction – particularly if you decide to book a crewed yacht charter.

### • Choosing Your Crew

A great crew can truly make the difference to your sailing holiday. Experienced AND passionate crew share stories about the history and culture, know the best locations to anchor and explore, cook fresh local food and much more. When choosing your crew, check whether they are local and experienced, read previous reviews or book through your broker. ### • When Should I Charter?

The sailing season in Croatia runs from mid-April

### • Where should I Sail?

With more than 1,000 islands in Croatia and an extensive coastline, planning your sailing route is another important factor. Sailing in Croatia can be broken up into – sailing Southern, Central or Northern routes. Be sure to research what each region offers, speak to your broker (if you have one) and check out our previous listed examples of sailing itineraries in to get an idea of possibilities.

### • Travel Arrangements

Research travel options ahead of time to ensure your travel is as pain-free as possible. For example, there are numerous flights to and from Split airport in peak-season; out of season they are less frequent. If you are driving, be sure to check estimated travel times and allow for peak-season traffic because you don't want to be late for your sailing holiday!

### • Check-in Procedure

Be sure to have all of your relevant documents – passports, licenses (and copies), charter package paperwork, bank cards, cash. Also, BEFORE you arrive, book any extras you want to have aboard (i.e. SUP, kayak, etc.) to save time at check-in. Check-in advice:

- Be on time and have all documents with you.
- Assign one or two people to the check-in, the rest of the group can do provisioning or relax.
- Be thorough and pay attention. You will be shown through the yacht with the technician; this is your chance to learn the ins and outs of the boat and point out any damage.
- Be patient. Allow up to an hour (maybe more in peak-season) for the check-in procedure. It won't be long 'til you are on your way; so, be patient, rushing through a yacht check-in serves no one.

### • What to Pack

Let us say "less is more". Remember you will be on a yacht, mostly living in light clothes or your swimsuit. Also, remember that there is limited storage space on a yacht, so we recommend bringing duffel bags over hard suitcases.

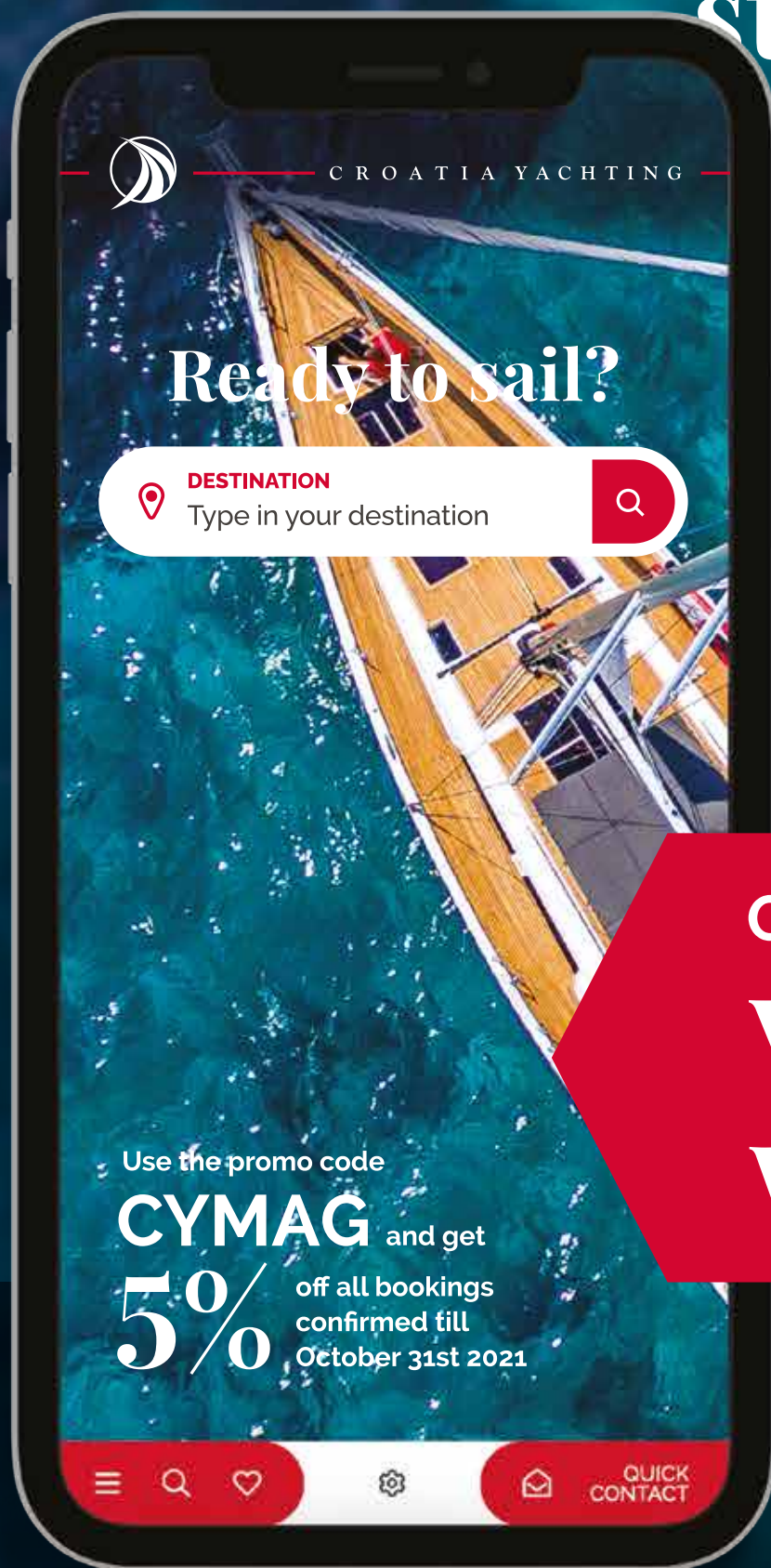

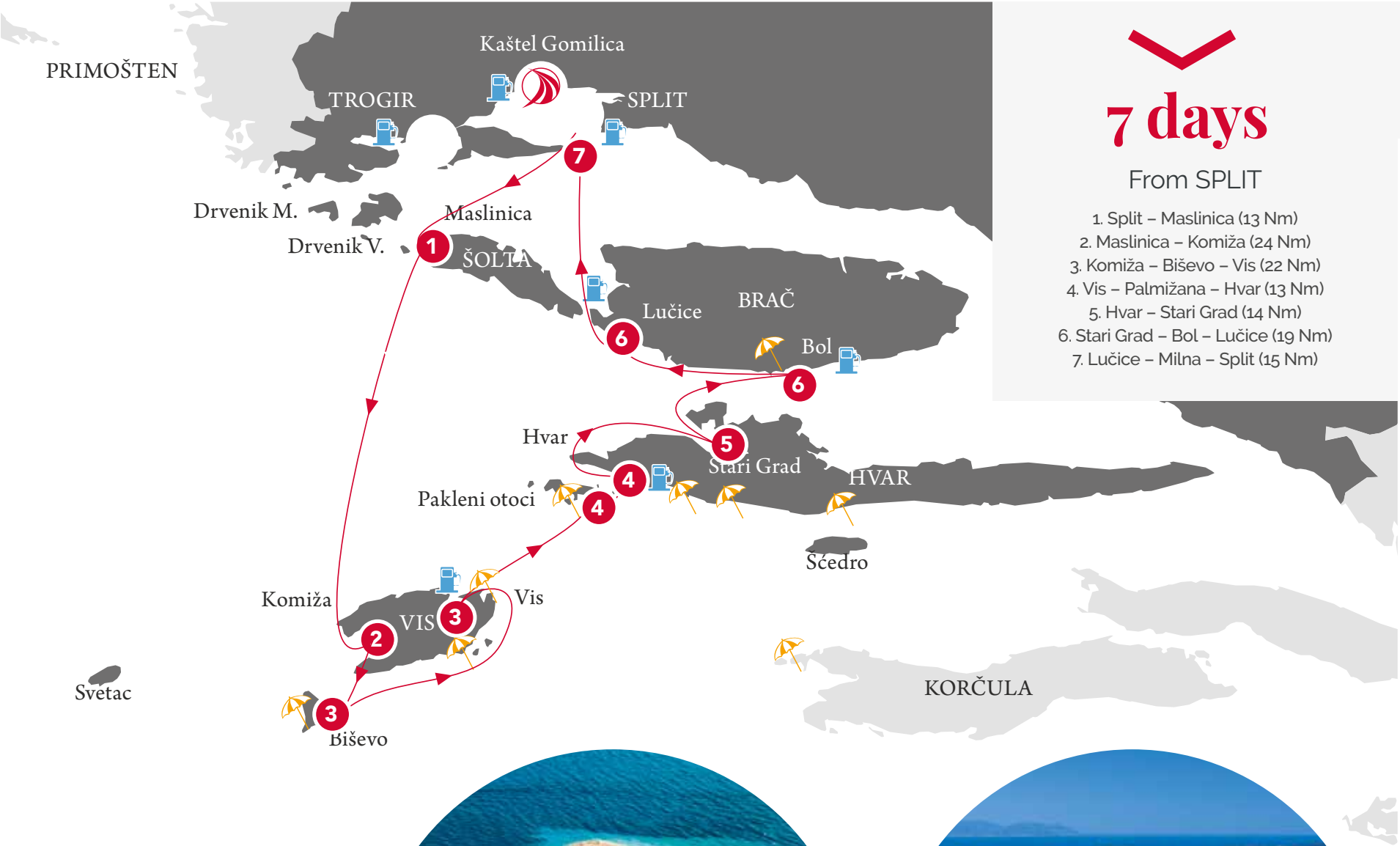

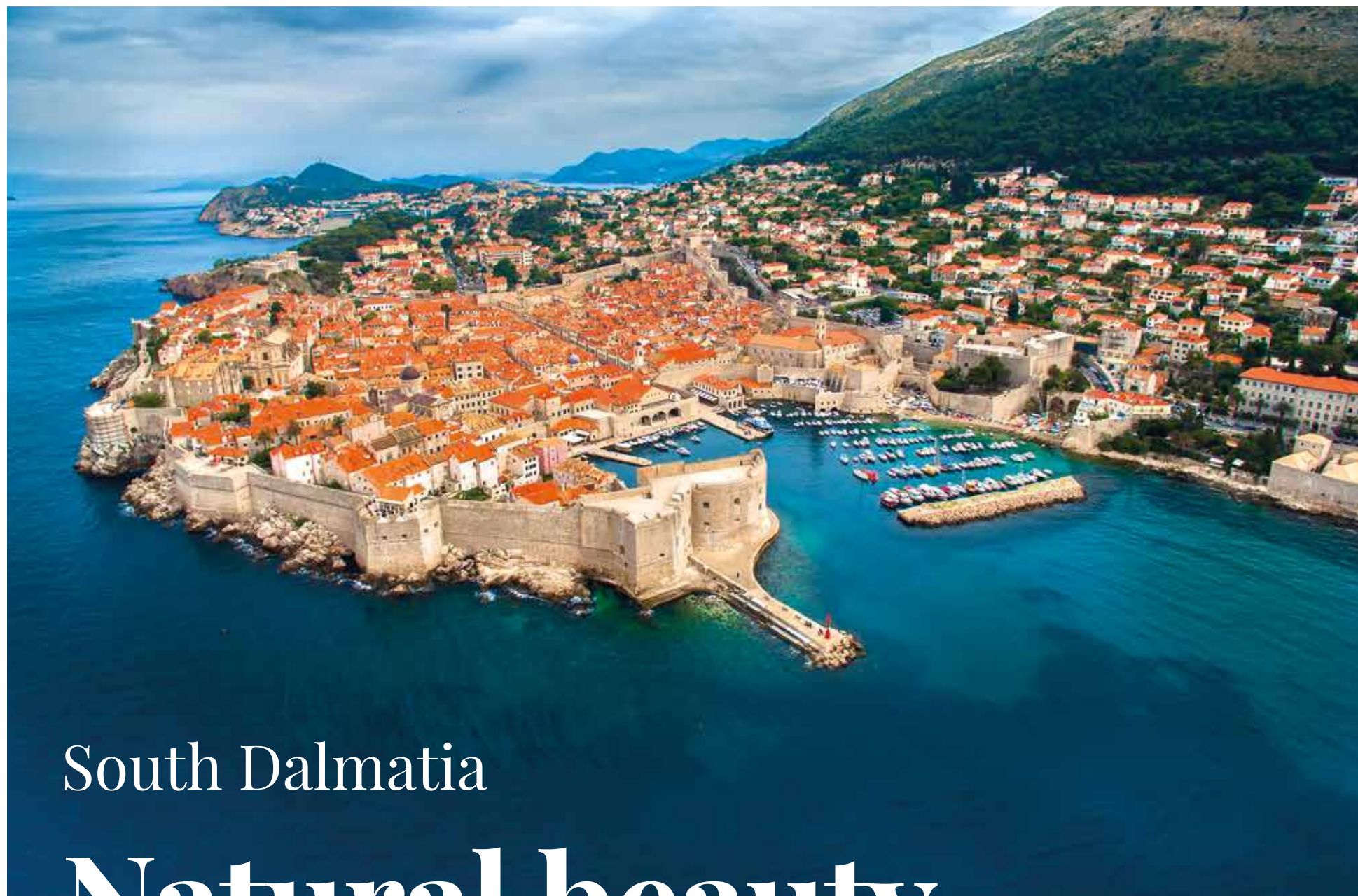

## Brijuni

After World War II the Brijuni became part of Yugoslavia, and President Josip Broz Tito made the Brijuni Islands his personal State Summer Residence. Almost 100 foreign heads of state visited Tito on his islands, along with celebrities including Elizabeth Taylor, Richard Burton, and many more! In 1991 four hotels on Veliki Brijun Island were opened, as well as a Safari Park, which holds animals given to Tito, such as two Indian elephants donated by Indira Gandhi - Sony and Lanka. There are other exotic animals here, all gifts from foreign diplomats. For example, you can see zebra, nilgai and waterbuck. Apart from natural beauty and Safari Park, history lovers will enjoy the Roman ruins. The famous historical site is Roman villa Rustica in Verige Bay which had residential and economic buildings. Brijuni is a small archipelago, with an area of around 7km<sup>2</sup>, but it is rich in history and culture. There, you can visit over 100 sites and buildings of archaeological and cultural value. Also, you'll find over 200 dinosaur footprints at four spots on Veliki Brijun!

## Kornati

A true nautical paradise- 89 islands, islets and reefs situated at your fingertips from our base in Biograd? The Kornati archipelago covers the area of about 320 km<sup>2</sup> and includes around 150 land units, located either permanently or frequently above the sea. It's interesting

to know that all the islands in Kornati archipelago are private property, mostly of people living on the nearby island of Murter. The landscape here is famous for being „Mars-like“ because of the stony ground. The sea life is a story of its own; rich with species and it's also protected. The biggest part of this National Park is the sea, not land. Important tips:

### • ZONES OF STRICT PROTECTION

The island of Purara and the area around it are under special protection- visitors and boats are not allowed to go there. Such as: Klint and Volić reefs, Mrtenjak islet, Kolobučar islet, Small Obručan and Great Obručan islets.

### • SAILING, ANCHORING AND DOCKING

Sailing is allowed in the whole of the Kornati National Park except in the zones of strict protection. Anchoring and overnighting are permitted in the following bays and coves: Stiniva, Statal, Lupeška, Tomasovac - Suha punta, Šipnate, Lučica, Kravljaci, Striznja, Vruje, Gujak, Opat, Smokica, Ravni Žakan, Lavsa, Piškera - Vela Panitula, Anica on Levrnaka, Podbižanj, and Koromašna.

### • SWIMMING AND DIVING

Swimming is allowed in the whole area of the Kornati National Park except in the zones of strict protection. Autonomous diving is allowed only in organised groups, with a licence for autonomous diving in the Kornati National Park obtained in advance.

## Krka

The estuary of Krka is just a few kilometres from Šibenik, and it offers you nice scenery for sailing through the Krka canyon up to the town of Skradin and the entrance point for the National Park. Krka has hollowed out its path through rock and has created its remarkable waterfalls with travertine cascades which are extremely rare in the world. There are 8 waterfalls and 10 lakes, among which the most popular is Skradinski buk - the longest waterfall on the Krka River and one of the best-known natural beauties of Croatia. Visovac island, with the Franciscan Monastery and the Church of Our Lady of Visovac, is one of the most important places of culture heritage and it can be reached. Roški slap is made up of a 22,5 high main

waterfall and numerous cascades and backwaters. The start of the barrier is built of a series of small cascades, called the necklace by the locals. If you feel sporty and have time, the Educational Hiking Trail (Stinice - Roški slap - Ozidana pećina) is for you! The total length of the trail is 8,5 km with an altitude difference of 176 m and the average walking time is 2,5 to 3 hours. The trail is filled with educational panels and excellent viewpoints.

## Mljet

Mljet National park is the most important protected area of the south of Dalmatia. The Park covers the western part of the island, full of various Mediterranean vegetation - Mljet is considered to be the greenest Dalmatian island. The island is also rich in cultural heritage. The most attractive monument is the complex of the Benedictine monastery from 12th century located in a small island in the middle of the Great Lake - The Islet od Saint Mary. Outside of the borders of the National park, there is famous Odysseus Cave, located on the southern coast of the island. It is named after the legend of Odysseus who was allegedly shipwrecked near the cave and remained "trapped" because of the nymph Calypso, who ruled the island. The cave can be entered by sea, by swimming or by a smaller boat, the entrance is about 4-5 meters wide.

## Recipe

## Spaghetti with mussels

### Ingredients

250 g spaghetti  
20-30 mussels  
4 pieces of garlic  
5 cherry tomatoes  
1 dL white wine  
Pepper  
1 smaller chili pepper  
2 spoons olive oil  
1 spoon capers  
2 dL whey

Boil spaghetti in salted water and dry when boiled. Put mussels in the pot and steam them in closed pot so that they discard their shell. Save the water where you steamed the mussels and put it aside. Put the chopped (or squished) garlic in a frying pan and fry on olive oil for a few moments. Add chopped cherry tomatoes and stir for a minute. Add your white wine, whey and the mussel liquid you've saved before. Put a pinch of milled pepper to spice it up a bit. Add a little chili pepper and capers. You should cook altogether until the liquid reduces when you should add your spaghetti and cook altogether for one more minute. Leave few mussel shells for decoration and before you put your dish on a plate- add mussels. Simple and delicious dish is ready for consuming! Enjoy!

## Recipe

### Gnocchi with grancigula crab

Homemade gnocchi with grancigula crab is one of their most sought after dishes, and chef was kind enough to share the recipe! With just a couple ingredients being necessary for this dish, it's perfect to prepare it even on your sailing vacation!

#### Ingredients

Olive oil  
Garlic  
Crab meat  
White wine  
Drop of cream  
Crab caviar (if available)

So, you'll need olive oil, garlic, crab meat, white wine, drop of cream, crab caviar (if available). First things first, over a medium heat fry the garlic on olive oil. Then, add crab meat and a glass of white wine. Then, the good kind – if it's good enough to drink it, it's good enough to cook with it. When the alcohol evaporates, pour in the cream, add the caviar and stir until the sauce is combined. Cook the gnocchi and add them to the rest of the dish, grate some parmesan cheese over the dish, a bit of freshly ground pepper and a tiny bit of salt! That's it – you have your proper Dalmatian dish ready and served!

## Recipe

### Fish in crazy water

The menu is based on seasonal catch, which gives this charming place a special touch. Given the specific location, one of the signature delicious dishes are ones with fresh fish included. A true Mediterranean essential at your plate!

#### Ingredients for two people

500 g fish file  
2 dL olive oil  
1 medium size onion  
4 garlic cloves  
100 g fresh parsley  
2 pieces stalk of celery  
2 medium size carrots  
2 medium size tomatoes  
Salt, pepper

Chop roughly onion, garlic, carrots, tomatoes, celery and parsley. Put olive oil in the pot, add all vegetables and put the fish files on top. Fry all together on light fire for 5-7 minutes. Add water to cover the fish, add salt and pepper, cover with the lid and cook 10-15 minutes. Serve with polenta or boiled potatoes.



Gastro mare is a seafood restaurant with open kitchen in beautiful and peaceful Kobaš bay on peninsula Pelješac. Kobaš is a small fisherman's village at the beginning of channel of Ston accessible by boat and car. Gastro mare offers daily changing menu depending on what was grown in the garden and what was caught in the sea. Chef Ante Toni Bjelančić composes the menu that consists of 3 to 5 courses. The menu is the result of traditional recipes with modern touch, using fresh vegetables from own garden and local farmers and fish from own catch, all seasoned with extra virgin olive oil.

Each course is followed by glass of wine recommended by the chef. The food is prepared in open kitchen just in front of you. The place is perfect for sailors and yachtsmen because it offers 14 mooring places, showers and beach bar with a beach. On top of that, for all guests is served traditional dalmatian breakfast that is included in price of the dinner. What is more, wine tasting can be organized in local wineries, such as trips to oyster farms and fishing trip with Gastro mare fishing boat. 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# A Dalmatian wine odyssey

Did you know that Croatia has more than 130 indigenous grape varieties? An astounding fact that many travellers don't know. And the best part? As you sail the coast of Croatia, you can see the patchwork of vineyards on the islands, and visit many unique wineries along the way. That is why we wrote the 'Adriatic Wine Odyssey'.

Our Wine Odyssey will guide you to some of the best wineries on your sailing route in central and southern Dalmatia. In the meantime, let us give you a quick introduction to some Croatian wine varieties.

## White Grape Varieties

As it's summer, we'll start with some crisp whites to delight; the perfect pairing to your fresh grilled fish and summer salads. Pošip is the Queen of Dalmatian whites, and grows in abundance on the Dalmatian islands. Vugava is indigenous to the island of Vis, and like many grapes, it is thought to have been brought to Croatia by the Greeks who first inhabited the area. Grk is a unique wine, the grape grows exclusively in a small town called Lumbarda on island Korčula, just outside of Korčula town. Notes of melon, pear, stone-fruit and salt are what you will find in a glass of Grk; it pairs well with a plate of prosciutto and cheese. Debit

is a dry white wine, with deep colour and full aromas, from the Šibenik area. Lighter in alcohol content than typical Dalmatian whites, Debit is perfect for a relaxed summer afternoon.

## Red Wines

Crljenak Kaštelanski is the origin of the famed Californian Zinfandel and grows in the hills above Split. Plavac Mali is the King of Dalmatian Reds. Plavac Mali is the dominant grape variety in Dalmatia, grown on the mainland and islands in abundance. A rich wine with forest berries, pepper and spice; when oak-aged it can develop beautiful depth and elegance. Be sure to try the famous appellations Dingač and Postup from the Pelješac Peninsula. Enjoy alongside your lamb peka. Babić is a ruby-red gem grown in Central Dalmatia, most well-known in the Primošten area.

### Putalj Winery, Kaštel Sućurac (Split)

Let's start in Kaštela, near Split which is home to the grape Crljenak Kaštelanski – known better as Zinfandel. Through genetic profiling, it was discovered that the origin of the famed Californian Zinfandel is Crljenak Kaštelanski (impress your wine friends with this knowledge when you return home)! Winemaker Anton Kovač blends 85% Zinfandel with 15% Plavac Mali (Zinfandel's offspring) and the wine is aged in oak barrels for 6 months, then in the bottle for a year before release, creating a wine of rich character and depth.

### Stina Winery, Bol, Brač island

Brač is famous for its white stone (rumoured to be in the White House), hence, this winery and wine is aptly named Stina (which translates as stone). # *Crewed or bareboat,* which is right for you?

- You want more privacy
- You are sailing on a budget

## Skippered Yacht

The first and most obvious reason people hire a skipper is that they do not have the licenses required, though this is not the only reason. There are numerous benefits to a skippered yacht charter – with a professional skipper aboard, you no longer need to worry about all of the responsibilities which means you can truly relax. - The island of Biševo has only 13 residents.

- The last specimens of the Mediterranean seal live in the Croatian aquatorium.
- The world famous beach Zlatni rat, located on the island of Brač changes its shape and colour depending on the winds.
- On the island of Susak women wear the shortest folk costumes in Europe having the only national costume that sits above the knee.
- The Croatian coastal area named Dalmatia is also the homeland of the dog breed Dalmatian, officially been recognised as Croatian. The origin dated from the church chronicles of the 16th century.

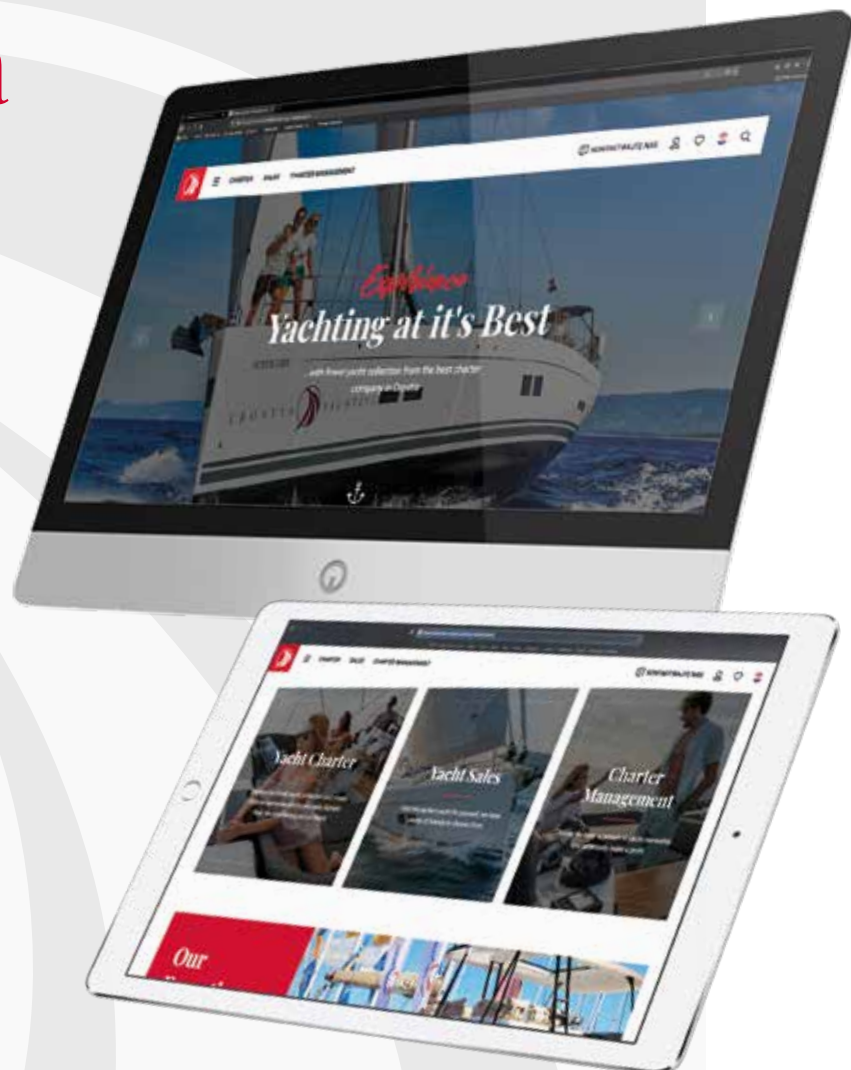
