

The area contains the beautiful coastal towns of Zadar, Šibenik and Primošten as well as numerous islands and three national parks.

The city of Zadar is unique for its thousand-year-old urban existence which makes it one of the oldest cities in Croatia. This is a city filled with cultural and historical heritage that can be seen just by walking through the city. Zadar is not too crowded, it's not overrun with tourists and its two unique attractions - the sound-andlight spectacle of the Sea Organ and the Sun Salutation – need to be seen and heard to be believed.

Šibenik is located in a deep inlet where the river Krka flows into the Adriatic Sea. Its port is very well protect-

ed from all winds and is ideal as a starting point of your cruise. Numerous churches, monasteries, palaces and four fortresses 'frame' the city, and also testify to the perseverance, renunciation and faith of generations of people of Šibenik.

Primošten is located on a peninsula that was an island once and is one of the most attractive destinations on the Adriatic coast with a typical look of an old fishing town.

## > Sea, sail and conserve

Arriving on board a new boat in a new country, it can be hard to think of ways to be kind to the environment in ways that still allow you to relax and enjoy your sailing holiday. And take it from someone who is out on the Adriatic all summer, there are definitely little ways that you can support locals, look after the environment and still have plenty of time and energy left to enjoy all of the amazing things that sailing in Croatia has to offer! My husband and I run 45 Degrees Sailing, offering crewed custom sailing holidays in Croatia, so we well know the struggles that many face when bareboat

chartering in this part of the world. So here are a few tips and tricks that we have picked up during our summers hosting guests from all around the world in this beautiful country. Having on hand reusable shopping bags is a great way to start! There are some fabulous printed tote bags for sale in Split (and on the islands too) that can be used on your sailing holiday and then be taken home as a special memento. They are light weight, easy to throw in your beach bag or handbag and help to avoid collecting single use plastic bags! Reusable containers are useful too and most charter









companies provide one or two. Don't be afraid to ask at the charter office if you can't find them on board. They are great when buying squishable things like fresh figs, grapes and very ripe tomatoes. Dalmatia has such amazing produce in the summer! Make the most of this by buying your fruit and vege outside of the super market. Ask around to see where fresh fruits and vegetables are being sold. Ports such as Trogir, Stari Grad and Šibenik have fruit and vegetable markets centrally located. Sometimes even in ports where there is no market, like Vis or Vrboska, there are still a couple of stalls

selling fresh produce. Often they also sell local cheeses, cured meats, honey and oils too! Local vendors are often very proud of their products (and quite rightly so) and love to offer tastings. It is also a very smart sales move, as once you have tasted the products its almost impossible to walk away without buying!

Pro tip: Don't buy olive oil from the super market! Domestically grown and pressed olive oil is waaay better. Ask at the port office, in a restaurant or even when you buy fruits and vege. Someone will sell you their olive oi! And it will be AWESOME!

You can show a little bit of kindness to the Adriatic Sea when you're showering too. Buying local shower products that are environmentally friendly is a great place to start. Croatian made products are often made from local ingredients like lavender, jasmine, nettle and honey, to name just a few. And look out for multi purpose products because this often means that one bottle can be used as a hand wash, body wash and even a sham poo! Thinking about conserving fuel is another way that you can be environmentally conscious on your sailing holiday. While using the motor is often necessary in summer when the wind dies off, as it often does during the beautiful sunny summer days, don't forget that your sailing boat has two large sails that can be a lot of fun when hoisted or unfurled! Choosing your next stop based on the weather conditions means that you can make the weather work for you instead of against you. Not only does this help save fuel, it also makes the journey a lot more pleasant for all on board.

These are a few of the little things that we can all do to help to retain the natural beauty of the Croatian islands. And help to make your sailing holiday one of the best holidays you'll ever have!





## Kaštela - Maslinica (island of Šolta)

Šolta is well known for its indigenous variety Dobričić and the fact that crossing of 'Crljenika' from Kaštela and already mentioned 'Dobričić' led to creating one of the most famous varieties in Croatia, 'Plavac mali'.

Gastro reference - recommended with meat dishes (grilled or traditionally roasted under a cast iron lid)

## Maslinica (island of Šolta) - Komiža (island of Vis)

Komiža, situated on the west side of the island Vis, is famous for its long fishing tradition and a lot of highquality wines, especially 'Vugava' and 'Plavac mali'. 'Vugava', characterized by the dark yellow color, robust flavor and dense note of sage, is a well-known white wine. Gastro reference - Vugava goes well with all kinds of fish, seafood and white meat. It shouldn't be served as an aperitif, but always with a meal.

## Komiža (island of Vis) - Porat (island of Biševo)

Biševo, first of all, famous for its Blue Cave, is also well known by its 'Plavac Mali' that grows on damp and sandy terrain of this beautiful, small island. These terrains influenced 'Plavac Mali' giving it heavier and richer note. The island has no winery or bottling plant, but a good drop can be found at local families or at the local res-

Gastro reference - Plavac, as a strong wine, is recommended with red meat and heavier food.

## DAY 4

## Porat (island of Biševo) - Hvar (island of Hvar)

Besides entertainment and leisure, Hvar offers a wide selection of restaurants with excellent fish and seafood delicacies.

As the fish is best suited to white and lighter wine we recommend 'Pošip Luviji' and 'Prvi Poljubac' (First Kiss) from a local winery that have been meticulously cultivating an original strain of 'Pošip' for many generations. Gastro reference - 'Pošip', chilled to 12 degrees, goes best with seafood and shellfish dishes.

## Hvar (island of Hvar) - Stari Grad (island of Hvar)

The north side of the island of Hvar is richer with premium wineries. In the nineties one of these wineries became famous with the finest Dalmatian Prosecco labeled 'Hektorovich'. 'Plavac Barrique' represents one of the finest croatian wines. We also have to point out 'Pošip' - exquisite white wine from Sv. Klement (Pakleni islands) Gastro reference - for dessert, with highly acclaimed prosecco Hektorovich, we recommend the dalamatian 'Rožata' - creamy pudding similar to crème brûlée.

## Stari Grad (island of Hvar) - Bol/Milna (island of Brač)

Brač, known for its lamb and numerous olive groves, also offers several excellent varieties of wine.

A Winery from Nerežišće offers superb red wines, 'Bosso' and 'Bročko Rič', characterized by dominated aromas that go excellent with Brač's well known lamb dishes. This winery also produces 'Spoža', one of the finest Croatian rosé wines. A winery from Murvica offers an excellent Barrique, 'Plavac Murvica'. On the southern side of the island, ia winery from Bol makes excellent white wines 'Pošip Stina' and 'Vugava Stina'. Gastro reference - stronger and more aromatic red wines are recommended with already mentioned Brač's lamb, grilled or roasted under a cast iron lid.

## Bol/Milna (island of Brač) - Kaštela

When coming back to Kaštela, make sure you try 'Crljenak Kaštelanski'. This just happens to be the most famous Croatian wine as the Californian Zinfandel is the direct descendent of this wine sort. The 'Crljenak Kaštelanski' is a bit softer than the 'Plavac' and it has a distinguishing fruity aroma for which this wine is highly appreciated.



- \*\* APA (ADVANCE PROVISIONING ALLOWANCE): amount of the charter fee is to be paid by the Client in addition to the charter fee which includes all fuel and relevant costs for the yacht and its tenders, as well as all harbor, customs, utility and other additional costs for the yacht, crew, client and guests during the entire charter period. The Client will be advised by the captain, at intervals, as to the disbursement of the A.P.A and will, if the balance remaining becomes insufficient, in light of current expenditure, pay to the captain, a sufficient sum to maintain an adequate credit balance. Prior to disembarkation at the end of the charter period, the captain shall present to the Client a detailed account of expenditures with as many supporting receipts as possible. The Client will pay to the captain the balance of the expenses or the captain/charter company will repay to the Client any balance overpaid, as the case may be. Payment for special requirements or equipment and/or shore transport and/or excursions and/or all other expenses not customarily considered part of the Yacht's costs may be required to be paid to the captain on board in addition to the charter fee and/or A.P.A.
